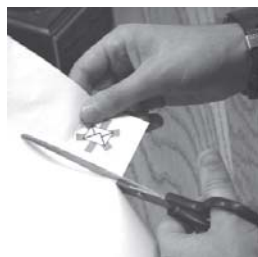
First, complete the medical history forms attached and place them in an envelope.

Write "Letter For Life" on the outside of the envelope. Then, wipe dry the inside rightward wall of your refrigerator and attach the envelope with masking or duct tape to the dried area. Be sure not to cover up your writing with the tape.

Next, cut out the red and black logo above. It is the logo with the black envelope on top of the red asterisk (EMS Star of Life).

Finally, place the logo on the top left outside corner of your entrance door to the house. The sticker alerts emergency personnel that your "Letter For Life" materials are in the refrigerator.
